# MIDNIGHT EXPRESS How Funds are Used

With all the contributions over the past years, we have raised over \$375,000 for this worthy and often overlooked cause. We strive to gain as much knowledge of the needs in our community so we can make the most impact with the funds we have raised. With new technology evolving we have donated a Giraffe Omni Bed to Children's Miracle Network that helps prevent blindness in premature babies. Having many causes of blindness, prevention is not always possible so we have also focused on education, and recreational enhancements for the visually impaired. Each year we meet with the grade school teachers who work with the visually impaired students and purchase the equipment needed to help make each year more successful for these students. We have discovered one of the most difficult transitions for the visually impaired is from grade school to college. By donating over \$100,000 to Columbus State and CVCC over the past several years, we have been able to provide scholarships for the visually impaired as well as enhance the technology available at the college level. Recreationally, we have supported the 2013 Beep Ball World Series along with the continued support of the local beep ball team.

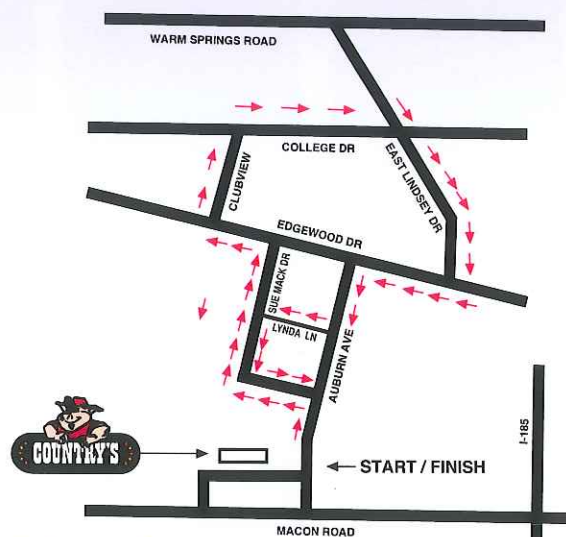

The Disability Service Center is the area's one-stop-shop for disability services and resources. DSC serves the entire Chattahoochee Valley region and works with numerous disabilities and needs. So what type of services do we offer to the visually impaired community? DSC will be able to assist you in accessing an enormous database of resources for everything from transportation to assistive technology. Perhaps employment is your goal. We will help you to enroll in our workplace readiness program. Through this program, you will learn things like resume creation, interview skills and workplace communication skills. Next, you will have the chance of completing an internship program or straight to employment, depending on your personalized training program. We also offer education and training in both Braille and technology support. Whether it is reading a Braille book and an email sent from a coworker, we can assist you in learning these skills. Our computer lab is stocked with multiple computers with different types of assistive technology that will make computer access possible for all. We can also help to guide you to numerous agencies geared at support for the visually impaired community such as the National Federation of the Blind or the Blinded Veterans Association. Do you have a passion for cooking or craft making? These are completely possible for someone with a visual impairment; we just may have to teach you a different way of completing these tasks. Our goal here at DSC is to offer whatever resources that might be needed to support an independent life style for everyone in the Chattahoochee Valley.
